Professor Ha-Joon Chang is one of the foremost thinkers on new economics and development. Ha-Joon has taught at the Faculty of Economics and Politics, University of Cambridge, since 1990. Ha-Joon's work has focused on alternative development economics.

In addition to numerous articles in journals and edited volumes, he has published 13 authored and coauthored books. Some of his most recent books include 23 things they don't tell you about Capitalism (2011), Bad Samaritans Rich Nations, Poor Policies, and the Threat to the Developing World (2007), Kicking Away the Ladder - Development Strategy in Historical Perspective (2002), which won the 2003 Myrdal Prize, and Restructuring Korea Inc. (with Jang-Sup Shin, 2004). By 2012, his writings will have been translated into 25 languages and published in 28 countries.

Ha-Joon Chang has also worked as a consultant for many international organizations, including various UN agencies (UNDESA, UNCTAD, WIDER, UNDP, UNIDO, UNRISD, INTECH, FAO, ECLAC, and ILO), the World Bank, the European Investment Bank, and the Asian Development Bank. He has also worked as a consultant for a number of governments on development policies (such as Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Ecuador, Indonesia, Japan, Namibia, Singapore, South Africa, the UK, Venezuela, and Vietnam).

Ha-Joon earned his B.A. from the Department of Economics, Seoul National University, Republic of Korea, and was awarded his M.Phil. and Ph.D. from the Faculty of Economics, University of Cambridge, U.K. He has also served as a member of the editorial board of the Cambridge Journal of Economics since 1992.
