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

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
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
It's not time to panic: Yes

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
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
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
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
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The Impact of China's Market Reforms on the Health of Chinese Citizens: Examining Two Puzzles  Despite sharp reductions in medical insurance coverage, rising medical care costs and unequal access, China has made dramatic progress in improving the health of its population since market reforms were launched. There was no deterioration in the health of the population as there had been in Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union. Health Reform and De Facto Federalism in China If articulated, federalism can constitute a ready-made institutional foundation for government purchasing of healthcare through conditional spending. 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result from cultural factors. Rather, it serves as a tool to secure payment of medical expenses and to mitigate the risk of radical malpractice liability which could be better resolved through less costly alternatives such as expanding medical insurance coverage and improving the records of informed consent made by patients.

China's Health Diplomacy in Africa

In recent years, Africa has regained a level of prominence in China's overall foreign policy strategy. Health diplomacy helps pave the way for Chinese oil companies to win mining rights for oil, platinum and other natural resources. However, a successful soft power strategy will need to consider public opinion and provide a means for connecting the health diplomacy with the larger goals.

#### Dilemmas of Access to Healthcare in China

China's State Council passed a landmark Health Care Reform Plan in January 2009. To a very large extent, it reflects an increased recognition that healthcare is a public service that cannot fully be subject to the dictates of the market economy. Many of the excesses in healthcare costs and costs of medications and treatment over the past ten years have been a direct result of privatisation and imposing market-based requirements on hospitals and physicians.
