

Priority 2: Promote Green Growth



Promote Trade and Investment in Environmental Goods and Services (EGS)

✓ <u>Reduce applied tariff rates</u> to 5% or less on EGS by 2015





Priority 2: Promote Green Growth



Other Actions:

- Phase out <u>fossil-fuel subsidies</u> voluntary reporting mechanism
- ✓ <u>Reduce energy intensity</u> by 45% by 2035
- ✓ Foster <u>economic and technical cooperation</u> for knowledge sharing to support energy-smart lowcarbon communities
- Implement measures to <u>combat illegal logging</u> and associated trade






Economic and Technical Cooperation


