## **PROGRAMME** ABOUT THE SPEAKER Fraser Cameron is Director of the EU-Asia Centre, a Senior Advisor at the European Policy Centre (EPC), and an adjunct 09.30 - 10.00am Arrival of Guests and Registration professor at the Hertie School of Governance in Berlin. Born in Scotland, Dr Cameron was educated at the University of St Andrews where he received an honours degree, Master of Arts, 10.00 - 10.05am Welcoming Remarks by in Political Science and History (1970). He then obtained a PhD in International Relations from the University of Tan Sri Rastam Mohd Isa Cambridge (1973). He was a Research Fellow at the University Chairman and Chief Executive of Hamburg (1973-74) and a Lecturer in Modern History at the ISIS Malaysia University of Kent (1974-75). From 1975 to 1989, he was a member of the British Diplomatic Service. Dr Cameron joined the European Commission in 1990 and was closely involved in policy issues related to the external relations of the EU. From 10.05 - 10.35am Remarks by 1999 to 2001, he was the Political Counsellor in the EU **Dr Fraser Cameron** Delegation in Washington DC. During his service in the EU, he Director worked on issues such as global governance, transatlantic EU-Asia Centre, Brussels relations, Asia, CFSP, arms control and enlargement. He joined the EPC on secondment from the Commission in 2002 and retired from the Commission in 2006. Dr Cameron has lectured widely in all continents and is a well-known media 10.35 – 11.30am Discussion commentator. He is an advisor to the BBC and to the UK government's Higher Education Panel on Europe. He was Director of the Europe-China Academic Network (ECAN) 2007-09.
