The 2024 UN Climate Change Conference (UNFCCC COP29) is scheduled to take place between 11-22 November in Baku, Azerbaijan. As the political climate grows increasingly polarised and the Global North-South divide deepens, all against the backdrop of worsening climate impacts and inadequate measures (including support mechanisms for developing nations) to address them, there is a need to realign the expectations and actions needed to achieve the equitable 1.5°C goal as outlined in the Paris Agreement. This is especially vital to Malaysia as a developing nation in a vulnerable region. As a precursor to COP29, this programme aims to explore Malaysia's role in international climate negotiations, provide an overview on key climate agendas and form a cohesive Malaysian narrative for national representatives and key stakeholders to put forward and pursue during the conference.
